The Milwaukee Angels offer baseball and softball instruction and development for all ages. Also, in 2019, our baseball program partnered with Cody Smith and the Midwest Halos to transition their skill set to the next level.

Today, the Milwaukee Angels provide the state's very best players with intensive skill development through high level coaching and opportunities to face top competition via state, regional and national tournaments. In 2024, the Milwaukee Angels will celebrate 30 years and will continue to be known in Southeastern Wisconsin for our success on and off the field.

## **INDOOR PRACTICES**

All indoor practices will take place at the Milwaukee Angels' 35,000 sq foot facility. Generally, each team is given 180 minutes (3 hours) of practice time each week that take place from November- April on both weeknight and weekday timeslots. Outoor practices take place at local fields determined by coach's preference and field availabilty.

We understand and appreciate that many of our players are multisport athletes and may not be able to attend every practice due to conflicting schedules. All players are expected to mark their availability for each practice/game using the TeamSideline application to allow for our coaches to make successful practice and game plans.









### **FACILITY**

"The HALO is the 35,000 square-foot indoor facility located in Muskego, Wisconsin used by the Midwest Halos and Milwaukee Angels baseball and softball teams to train and develop. All of our teams utilize the facility and its amenities throughout the year. Individual players have the ability to reserve cage time as part of their annual players fees as we prioritize the training and development of our athletes. The Halo Facility features a 6,000 sq. ft. weight room, a full infield, 5-8 cages, 160 ft. long toss/velocity tunnel, pitching machines and a plyo wall. The facility features a parents waiting area with digital viewing and window access to the training facility, as well as, a team store and concession stand for special events.

#### **FUNDRAISING**

The WYSA will hold one major fundraising event per year, which will be on February 10th, 2024. The Milwaukee Angels & Midwest Halos Swing by Social is a family friendly event with games, raffle baskets, 50/50 raffles, great food with popular food trucks and cash bar.

This is a mandatory fundraiser for all families within both programs and it is the responsibility for each player to contribute the following:

- Each player will be responsible for selling 10 tickets at \$20.00 per ticket. Families with multiple athletes in the organization (3+) will only be responsible for a maximum of 20 tickets.
- Upon accepting your player agreement, each family will have the option to "opt-out" of the Swing by Social fundraising responsibilities for a one time fundraising fee of \$400.
- For families who do not ""opt-out"" of their fundraising responsibilities and elect to participate in the Swing by Social fundraising responsibilities, you agree to the above requirements.
- The Halo Facility and each individual team may host their own fundraising events, outside of the annual Swing by Social. These events are at the discretion of the organization and/or the individual coach and may be an additional requirement.
